

WALK-IN CLINIC PATIENT GUIDELINES

The FHT Walk-In Clinic runs Tuesdays & Wednesdays from 4-6pm. Check-in begins at 3:45.

The Nurse Practitioner will see you for:

1. Coughs/colds
2. Earaches and sore throats
3. Infections
4. Rashes/skin conditions
5. Strains/sprains

Services **NOT** available through Walk-In Services:

1. Requests for lab tests or other diagnostics (x-rays, MRI, etc.)
2. Narcotics and Controlled Substances
3. Severe Injuries or Major Wounds
4. Immunizations
5. Stitches
6. Forms

The following symptoms and/or conditions should present to the **Emergency Department**:

1. Child with fever over 39⁰C or 102⁰ F
2. Fractured Bones
3. Concussions and/or dizziness
4. Chest Pains
5. Severe Abdominal Pain

****The best place for an Acute Mental Health Episode is the Emergency Room****
